Kate will show you how to attach your fabric to the form to create a new vessel. You can then begin stitching into the surface using various threads to create extra surface texture.

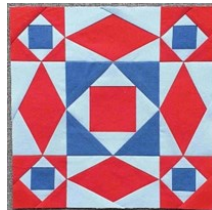

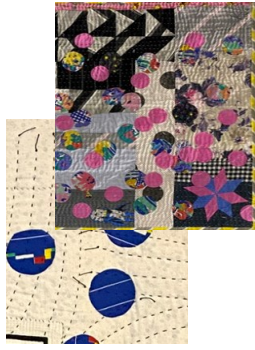
