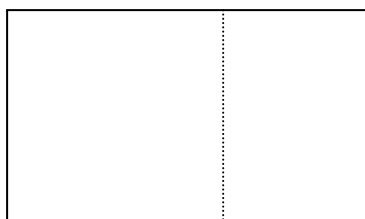
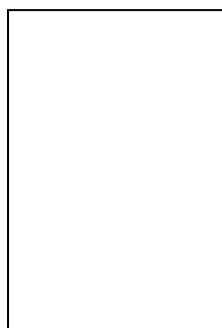

**Conditions:**

1. A 4" sleeve must be sewn securely to the top edge on the reverse of the quilt (if appropriate).
2. A label must be sewn to the back of the item (or appropriate inconspicuous place) giving the maker's name and address. You will be supplied with a raffle style ticket when you hand in the work. The other half goes on the quilt.
3. **Items for sale.** Please attach an envelope containing your name, address, tel. no. and email to the back of each item you want to sell. 10% commission to Oast. You, the quilter are responsible for the arrangements of the sale.
4. No item may be removed from the exhibition until after the show.
5. Entry of a piece of work assumes that the maker gives permission for it to be photographed and used in publicity.
6. Although every care will be taken in the handling and hanging of the submitted item, all entries are exhibited at the owner's risk.
7. The owner will insure the item her/himself if appropriate.
8. All items for display should ideally be brought to the September Oast meeting or **at the very latest** be delivered to St. Andrew's Church, Canterbury by **2.00pm on Thursday 22 October**. **Items delivered any later might not be displayed.**
